

OSAKA CASTLE BARRIER-FREE MAP



BARRIER-FREE HIGHLIGHTS

- The main tower of Osaka Castle is a barrier-free facility with elevators.
- The route to the main tower of Osaka Castle is accessible by a paved ramp.
- There are steep slopes on some parts of the route, and the height difference and angle varies depending on the station and park entrance.
- If using the ramp is burdensome, feel free to use the park's Road Train or Electric Car transportation systems (strollers and wheelchairs boarding welcome).





Routes to the Main Tower of Osaka Castle

[has differences in distance and elevation]

A Osaka Metro Tanimachi Line / Keihan Line Temmabashi Station (T22) (KH03)




- Keihan Line** Exit the east ticket gate and go up the ramp at **Exit 16** to arrive in front of the local police station. Go right (south).
Osaka Metro Tanimachi Line Take the elevator up at **Exit 3** and turn to the left (east). Go straight along Koraibashi-dori Avenue where you will be able to see the main tower of Osaka Castle.
- Go south from the park entrance along the moat, and continue until you reach the Otemon Gate.
- Go through the Otemon Gate, then continue straight ahead until you reach the Sakuramon Gate, which leads to the main tower of Osaka Castle.



Caution The route from Gokurakubashi Bridge to Osaka Castle has steep slopes and areas without handrails. Take care when using this route.


C Osaka Metro Chuo Line / Tanimachi Line Tanimachi 4-chome Station (C18) (T23)



- Osaka Metro Chuo Line** Take the elevator at **Exit 11**, turn to the right (east), cross the main road at the crosswalk, and continue to the park entrance.
Osaka Metro Tanimachi Line Take the elevator at **Exit 1-A**, go east along Honmachi-dori Avenue, and continue to the park entrance.
- Go straight north from the park entrance and continue until you reach Otemon Gate, which will be visible on your right.
- Go through Otemon Gate and continue going straight. You will reach the Sakuramon Gate, which leads to the main tower of Osaka Castle.



B JR Osaka Loop Line Osakajokoen Station (JR-007)



- JR Lines** Exit the station and use the pedestrian deck that connects to the JO-TERRACE OSAKA park complex.
- Go across the pedestrian overpass, then take the elevator in the building on the left down to the 1F. (There are restaurants and convenience stores nearby.)
- Continue along the ground-level path to the main tower as indicated by the signs.
- Continue to Aoyamon Gate, turn left, and go up Gangizaka Slope.
Caution If you turn right, the route from Gokurakubashi Bridge to the main tower is steep.
- When taking the road along the moat, you will reach the Sakuramon Gate, which leads to the main tower of Osaka Castle.



D JR Osaka Loop Line / Osaka Metro Chuo Line & Nagahori Tsurumi-ryokuchi Line Morinomiya Station (JR-006) (C19) (N20)



- JR Lines** Exit the station, cross at the crosswalk and continue to the park entrance.
Osaka Metro Chuo Line / Nagahori Tsurumi-ryokuchi Line Take the **Exit 3-C** elevator up to ground level.
- Without entering the park, follow along the elevated Chuo Odori Street.
**The routes from inside the park require taking stairs or going a longer distance (approx. 1.8 km) to the Aoyamon Gate.*
- Go past Osaka International Peace Center and continue to the park entrance with the "Barrier-Free Route" sign.
- Continue following the directions on the sign and go straight ahead to reach the Sakuramon Gate, which leads to the main tower of Osaka Castle.

From Outside to the Main Tower Entrance

There is a special elevator from the ground-level ticket counter to the entrance of the main tower of Osaka Castle. The route from where the elevator arrives to the entrance has some steep slopes (approx. 7 degrees).







Transportation within the park



Road Train

Runs from Morinomiya Station and JO-TERRACE OSAKA to Gokurakubashi Bridge.

- Offers two boarding methods, a wheelchair lift and a ramp, and can be used while seated in a wheelchair.
- There are weight-based restrictions for electric wheelchairs, so please check with us if you use one.
- The electric car system offers alternative transportation between Gokurakubashi Bridge and Hokoku Shrine.

*Car Parking in Front of Osakajoko Station is only for wheelchair users, and reservations must be made in advance.

Electric Car

Runs from Bambacho near Tanimachi 4-chome Station to Sakuramon Gate. Some cars are equipped with wheelchair ramps, and wheelchair users can board while seated in their wheelchairs.




Accessible toilets and nursing rooms inside the park



Some of the accessible toilets inside the park include a diaper-changing station and baby chair. In addition, the following barrier-free toilets in commercial facilities inside the park are multi-functional, and nursing rooms are also available in restrooms other than the accessible toilets.

In the main tower of Osaka Castle

- There are barrier-free toilets on the 2F (no diaper-changing station, baby chair or ostomate facilities).
- Diaper-changing stations are available only in the 2F women's restroom. A staff member will show men to a separate room with a diaper-changing station if needed, so please feel free to ask.
